# Welcome to Camp St. Gregory!

We're excited to announce that this summer St. Gregory is offering numerous, thrilling summer camps! Any student entering Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> Grade can find fun and exhilarating activities at Camp St. Gregory!

Each of our summer camps was created with children in mind. The curriculum encourages students to learn new skills, talents, and techniques.

The programs cover some of our favorite things: cooking, science, Greek mythology, arts and crafts, and the list goes on!

Camp Dates are June 13-17, June 20-24, June 27-July 1, July 11-15, July 18-22, July 25-29, and August 1-5. There are morning and afternoon sessions. Lunch care will be provided for students who are signed up for both morning and afternoon sessions.

The camps prices are \$75 per session. (Some camps also have a \$10 materials fee). Space is limited so registration is on a first-come-first-serve basis. We can't wait to see you at Camp St. Gregory!

## Session 1: June 13-17, 9:00 am -11:30 am

- 1.1 CSI St. Gregory (Creative Science Investigations) (Gr. 4-5) with Linda Harvey and Bridget Chapman:** During this week, campers will use science investigation methods and experiments to solve a mystery.
- 1.2 Fiddlin' Fun (Gr. 3-5) with Melissa Baxley:** Let's gather around the campfire and have a "pickin' session." That's fiddle talk for "Let's learn some new music!" Students will learn American folk and fiddle tunes from Mark O'Connor's Violin Method. We'll have fun together learning new tunes and playing musical games. Students will need to purchase the Mark O'Connor Violin Method Book 1 book/cd combo through the school.
- 1.3 Spanish-Only Zone (PK-K) with Inés Benedict:** Early childhood with a twist – everything will be completely in Spanish! Campers will cover the basics while doing fun activities like singing, dancing, cooking, and playing, all in a Spanish-only environment.

## Session 2: June 13-17, 12:30pm-3:00pm

- 2.1 More Mythology! (must have completed 4<sup>th</sup> grade) with Linda Harvey:** Stories, crafts, and projects based on the minor gods and goddesses of Greek mythology.
- 2.2 Fiddlin' Fun for Younger Students (Gr. K-2) with Melissa Baxley:** Younger students will explore the world of American folk music and fiddle tunes by using songs from Mark O'Connor's Violin Method. We'll include stories and games to enrich our experience while continuing to develop fundamental technique. Students will need to purchase the Mark O'Connor Violin Method Book 1 book/cd combo through the school.

- 3.1 St. Gregory Scrappers (Gr. 3-5) with Lisa Bate:** Campers will create a scrapbook featuring St. Gregory Cathedral School for long-lasting memories. (\$10 materials fee)

regrouping, multiplication and division. We will also read a small novel and have some fun activities to help us with comprehension and writing.

## **8.2 Cupcake Craze (Gr. 1-3) with Dana Fergerson and Courtney**
